Griffith Park Sparking Brut is more zingy in style, fresh citrusy aromas and flavours but with a lovely depth and creaminess to finish. Who needs champagne? These Aussie winners are available from Asda stores, normally £7.13, but currently on promo at £4.93 — chill and enjoy!
